III. Approval of Minutes: Motion to approve June 2013 Meeting Minutes made by Commissioner Urquidez; seconded by Commissioner Richardson. Motion passed.

IV. Public Comment: (3 minutes)

V. Resignations & New Commissioners: Commissioner Comiskey resigned due to a full time teaching assignment. Commissioner Molina resigned because she relocated to a different county. New appointments are pending the approval of Judge Nichols.

VI. Police Department Inspections: Commissioner Stodolski reported that Welfare & Institutions Code § 209(b) mandates that the Juvenile Justice Commission inspect police departments who report having detained juveniles. Judge Nichols had originally indicated it was not required due to the section of the code that states the detention must be in excess of 24 hours. We will only inspect the police departments that reported having detained minors during the fiscal year, as mandated by section 209(b).

VII. Delinquency Court Workshop: Commissioner Stodolski announced that the judges will be conducting a Delinquency Court Workshop to provide an overview of the Delinquency Court process. Commissioners are encouraged to attend.

VIII. Probation Report: David Coughran, Division Manager of Juvenile Services (which is integrated into CSOC) reported three years ago they would typically have 300 juveniles and they currently have less than 200.

Donovan Hazen will be transferring out of JDF effective the end of this month and Joe Netameyer will take his place.

The alternative school in Roseville off Sunrise is moving to an updated facility on Menlo (off Sunset) in Rocklin.

Probation is composing a system improvement plan for the state that bolsters family information on the front end of the process so juveniles can be placed with family members if at all possible. They are also working on an assessment system (JAIS) to guide them in treatment.

Committee Reports:

IX. Inspection Committee:

Commissioner Bader reported that Commissioner Stodolski will take Commissioner Comiskey's place on this committee. The committee is working on redesigning the inspection questionnaires and redesigning the inspection process.

X. Hearing Committee:

Commissioner Stodolski reported that there is no change since June.

XI. Executive Committee:

Commissioner Stodolski reported that new Commissioners have been interviewed. Sept 6th and Sept 13th will be the new Commissioner orientation from 10-12 and 12-2. He requested help from Commissioners interested in assisting with the training.

The Policies & Procedures are close to being finished. Commissioner Richardson will add the Table of Contents.

Barbette Shepherd addressed the commission and offered to be on the PCJJC if openings occur. She is working on an advanced degree in the Y Generation. Her husband is also interested in being on PCJJC. They live in Foresthill and are planning to move to Placerville. Commissioner Stodolski asked her to talk to him after the meeting.

XII. Community Relations:

Commissioner Richardson reported that a Strategic Plan is framed and they are looking for more people to be on this committee. They have mocked up a brochure.

They intend to get as many organizations linked to the commission as possible.

XIII. Juvenile Court Evaluations:

Commissioner Stodolski reported that Commissioner Attwater is compiling the data for a report. The goal is to finish a report in the next couple of months.
