**The meeting was called to order at 6:04 P.M.**

**Approval of Minutes:** The approval of the March minutes was tabled.

**Visit from Joe Nettemeyer and Melanie Esque:** Mr. Nettemeyer and Mrs. Esque provided the commissioner with an update about the operation of juvenile hall. They discussed the increase of juvenile hall population. This increase has no identifiable cause but may just be seasonal fluctuation. In addition, they described the positive behavior intervention and support (PBIS) system which provided incentives to youth for good behavior, a system which they described as a success. They also discussed the implementation of additional programs to enrich the youth's experiences such as art and other programs that are available to the youth while in juvenile hall and after discharge.

**Action Planning:** The commission tabled further discussion of the action planning session.

**Upcoming Inspections:** For the upcoming inspections, the commission discussed the need to look into the process for documentation of reports in adherence to policies such as PREA, even when the credibility of such a report is
