_____ 14. _____ Parents will provide a consistent, safe, hazard free, alcohol and drug free environment. Neither party shall be under the influence of alcohol or non-prescription drugs while child is in their care.

_____ 15. _____ If minor children are to be transported out of the State of California for more than 24 hours; each party must provide the other with prior notice to include dates, location of travel, and telephone numbers.

_____ 16. _____ Parties agree that they will provide each other a 45-day prior written notice of a change of address. This does not permit either party to relocate the children to another county without a mutual agreement or a court order.

_____ 17. _____ All transportation for the exchange of the child(ren) shall be shared equally. Subject to valid Driver's License, insurance, and proper car seats. Each parent agrees that the child(ren) is/are to be transported only by a properly licensed and insured driver in an insured vehicle with a proper, federally approved child restraint system.

_____ 18. _____ Both parents may take an active role in child's education, and attend school conferences or parent-teacher meetings separately or together.

_____ 19. _____ Either parent may return to mediation upon court order if circumstances change and/or this agreement reflects that it is not in the best interest of the child(ren), and the parties cannot resolve the issues between themselves.
