COURTHOUSES

Face coverings are required for all, regardless of vaccination status, while in courtrooms. For all other locations inside our courthouses, face coverings are strongly encouraged for those who are vaccinated and required for the unvaccinated.



FILINGS

eFiling is MANDATED for attorneys and represented parties. Self represented parties are encouraged to use eFiling, instructions for eFiling are available on the court's website.

SELF HELP CENTER

Telephone and video appointments offered. Walk in services for tenants and landlords offered Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 8am to 9:15 am at the Gibson Courthouse. Live Chat available on the court's website on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays from 8am to noon.

JURY SERVICE

No jury trials will begin between August 30, 2021 and September 24, 2021.

CIVIL CASES

eFiling mandated for attorneys and represented parties. Live Chat available on the court's website on Mondays, Tuesdays and Fridays from 8am until 10am, and on Wednesdays from 3:15 pm until 4:15 pm.

CRIMINAL CASES

Filings may be submitted by eDelivery. All general out of custody misdemeanor hearings set between August 30, 2021 and October 1, 2021 are postponed 8 weeks. Video appearances available, see the court's website for details. Live Chat available on the court's website on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 3pm until 4pm.

FAMILY LAW CASES

eFiling mandated for attorneys and represented parties. Family centered case resolution (FCCR) six month and twelve month conferences set between August 30, 2021 and October 1, 2021 will be dropped from calendar and not heard. All 18 month FCCRs will remain as set. Video appearance may be available, subject to request and judicial approval. Live Chat available on the court's website on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 10am until noon and on Tuesdays from 3:15 pm until 4:15 pm.

JUVENILE CASES

TRAFFIC CASES

All traffic and non traffic infraction pre trial and post trial matters set between August 30, 2021 and October 1, 2021 will be postponed to an available date at least 8 weeks from the currently scheduled court date. This includes all pay or appear dates for traffic infractions. Defendants may request a remote appearance during this time period.
