STANDING ORDER RE COVID-19
PANDEMIC: EXTENSION OF
EMERGENCY ORDERS RE
ALL CIVIL, APPELLATE AND
FAMILY LAW MATTERS

In light of the national COVID-19 pandemic and in conjunction with the March 30, 2020 Order of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California along with the General Order re: Implementation of Emergency Relief issued by the Superior Court of Placer County on March 17, 2020 and General Order #2 re: Implementation of Emergency Relief issued by the Superior Court of Placer County on April 10, 2020, the court makes the following orders, effective immediately:

- **CONTINUANCE OF CIVIL HEARINGS [Excludes Temporary Guardianships, Temporary Conservatorships, Civil Harassment Restraining Orders, Elder Abuse Restraining Orders, Petitions Regarding Firearms, Unlawful Detainer Stays, and Other Emergency Relief]:** The court will continue all

1 hearings in civil cases set between April 13, 2020, and May 8, 2020,
2 except for Temporary Guardianships, Temporary Conservatorships,
3 Civil Harassment Restraining Orders, Elder Abuse Restraining
4 Orders, petitions regarding firearms, unlawful detainer stays, and
5 other requests for emergency relief, to an available date at least
6 eight weeks from the currently scheduled court date.

7 • **CONTINUANCE OF CIVIL TRIALS [Jury and Court Trials]:** The
8 court will continue all civil trials set between April 13, 2020, and
9 May 8, 2020, to an available date at least eight weeks from the
10 currently scheduled trial date.

11 • **CONTINUANCE OF SMALL CLAIMS/UNLAWFUL DETAINER**
12 **HEARINGS:** The court will continue all small claims and unlawful
13 detainer hearings set between April 13, 2020, and May 8, 2020, to
14 an available date at least eight weeks from the currently scheduled
15 court date.

16 • **CONTINUANCE OF APPELLATE DIVISION HEARINGS:** The
17 court will continue all appellate division hearings set between April
18 13, and May 8, 2020, to an available date at least eight weeks from
19 the currently scheduled court date.



- 1 • **CONTINUANCE OF FAMILY LAW MATTERS [Excludes Matters**
2 **Set Through Request for Emergency Order, Domestic**
3 **Violence Restraining Orders, Adoptions, Petitions for**
4 **Freedom from Custody and Control, and Termination of**
5 **Parental Rights]**: The court will continue all family law matters set
6 between April 13, 2020, and May 8, 2020, except matters set
7 through a request for emergency order; domestic violence
8 restraining orders; adoptions; petitions for freedom from custody
9 and control; and termination of parental rights, to an available date
10 at least eight weeks from the currently scheduled court date.
