

STANDING ORDER RE COVID-19
PANDEMIC:
ALL CIVIL, APPELLATE AND
FAMILY LAW MATTERS

In conjunction with the March 17, 2020 Order of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the March 17, 2020 request for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Placer County, and the General Order re: Implementation of Emergency Relief issued by the Superior Court of Placer County on March 17, 2020, and under the authority of Code of Civil Procedure section 128 and California Rules of Court, rule 10.603, the court makes the following orders, effective immediately:

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
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- **CONTINUANCE OF FAMILY LAW MATTERS [Excludes Child Custody/DVROs; Freedom from Custody and Control, Adoption, and Termination of Parental Rights]:** The court will continue all family law matters, **except for child custody, domestic violence restraining order matters, freedom from custody and control, adoption, and termination of parental rights** set between March 18, 2020, and April 10, 2020, to an available date at least eight weeks from the currently scheduled court date.
