PANDEMIC:
TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF
COLLECTION EFFORTS

In conjunction with the California Franchise Tax Board's decision to suspend Non-Tax Collection Debt collection efforts, effective March 20, 2020 until further notice, to ensure California taxpayers have access to funds that may be needed, and the March 17, 2020 Order of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the March 17, 2020 request for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Placer County, and the General Order re: Implementation of Emergency Relief issued by the Superior Court of Placer County on March 17, 2020, and due to the State of Emergency declared by Governor Gavin Newsom on March 4, 2020, and under the authority of Code of Civil Procedure section 128 and


1 California Rules of Court, rule 10.603, the Court makes the following orders
2 regarding Placer County Revenue Services' current collection efforts on the
3 Court's behalf, effective immediately:

5 • Placer County Revenue Services shall not impose any civil
6 assessments for failure to pay effective immediately through
7 April 30, 2020. Revenue Services shall request direction from the
8 Court no more than ten days and no less than five days prior to
9 April 30, 2020 on whether this order is extended.
- 10
11 • Placer County Revenue Services shall liberally grant deferrals of
12 payments due to hardships presented by the current state of
13 emergency.
