STANDING ORDER RE COVID-19
PANDEMIC:
TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF
COLLECTION EFFORTS

In conjunction with the California Franchise Tax Board's decision to suspend nontax debt collection efforts (effective March 20, 2020), the Orders of Chief Justice of California issued in response to the Placer County Superior Court's requests for emergency orders, and the court's orders implementing emergency relief; and due to the State of Emergency declared by Governor of California on March 4, 2020; and under the authority of Code of Civil Procedure section 128 and California Rules of Court, rule 10.603, the Court makes the following orders regarding Placer County Revenue Services collection efforts on the court's behalf:

1. Placer County Revenue Services shall not impose any civil assessments for failure to pay effective May 1, 2020 through


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July 15, 2020. Revenue Services shall request direction from the Court no more than ten days and no less than five days prior to July 15, 2020 on whether this order is extended.

2. Placer County Revenue Services shall liberally grant deferrals of payments due to hardships presented by the current state of emergency.
