STANDING ORDER RE COVID-19  
PANDEMIC: EXTENSION OF  
EMERGENCY ORDERS RE  
ALL CIVIL, APPELLATE AND  
FAMILY LAW MATTERS


In light of (1) declarations of a state of emergency by federal, state, and local governments due to the COVID-19 / novel coronavirus global pandemic; (2) Executive Orders by the Governor of the State of California; (3) orders and directives of the Chief Justice of the State of California; (4) Emergency Local Rules of Court adopted by the Placer County Superior Court; and under the authority of Code of Civil Procedure section 128 and California Rules of Court, rule 10.603, the court issues the following temporary standing order:

- **CONTINUANCE OF CIVIL TRIALS [Jury and Court Trials]:** The court will continue all civil trials set between May 11, 2020, and May 29, 2020, to an available date at least eight weeks from the currently scheduled trial date.

- 1 • **CONTINUANCE OF SMALL CLAIMS/UNLAWFUL DETAINER**  
2 **HEARINGS:** The court will continue all small claims and unlawful  
3 detainer hearings set between May 11, 2020, and June 5, 2020, to  
4 an available date at least eight weeks from the currently scheduled  
5 court date.
- 6 • **CONTINUANCE OF FAMILY LAW TRIALS:** The court will continue  
7 all family law trials set between May 11, 2020, and May 29, 2020,  
8 to an available date at least eight weeks from the currently  
9 scheduled court date.
- 10 • **CONTINUANCE OF FAMILY LAW MATTERS SET MAY 15, 2020**  
11 **[Includes ONLY Settlement Conferences, Trial Confirming**  
12 **Conferences, and Trial Assignment Conferences]:** All family  
13 law settlement conferences, trial confirming conferences, and trial  
14 assignment conferences currently set May 15, 2020, will be  
15 continued to June 12, 2020, for trial assignment.
- 16 • **DROPPING/CONTINUANCE OF FAMILY CENTERED CASE**  
17 **RESOLUTION CONFERENCES:** All 6-month and 12-month Family  
18 Centered Case Resolution Conferences currently set between May  
19 11, 2020 and September 1, 2020, will be dropped. All 18-month  
20 Family Centered Case Resolution Conferences currently set between  
21 May 11, 2020, and July 31, 2020, will be continued to an available  
22 date in August 2020.
