

**Video Appearances for Traffic Infraction
Hearings at Placer Veterans Stand Down**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that traffic infraction hearings may be held at the Placer Veterans Stand Down, to be held May 14th to May 16th, 2019. It is further ordered that said hearings may be held via video appearance between the event location and the Howard G. Gibson Courthouse in Roseville, California. These appearances are being authorized in support of veterans addressing outstanding traffic court matters while attending this event and not for any other traffic proceedings heard by the court. Video appearances are voluntary and defendants will be asked to agree to such appearances. The court's provision of video appearances for this purpose shall comply with applicable requirements for such hearings established in California Rules of Court, rule 4.220.
