1. S-PR-0008964 Cornelius, Richard-In Re the Conservatorship of

Appearance is required for 4th conservator account hearing.
Additional allegations / information needed: conservator should be prepared to address the following unexplained spending during the 4th account:

- \$3,240.00 related to the Sacramento Rivercats
- \$6,850.00 related to the Sacramento Kings
- \$6,598.92 in gifts and other support for conservatee's father
- \$8,314.27 for a life insurance policy

As to the insurance, conservator should provide points and authorities supporting conservator's power to obtain new life insurance policies, as well as factual allegations explaining the need for and purpose of the policy and any other options to meet said needs and purposes.

2. S-PR-0011604 In Re the Conservatorship of Bingham, Nancy

Appearance is required for hearing on 1st / final conservatorship account.

Clarification is needed: the account shows no income of any kind during 17 months of conservatorship other than de minimus interest income, without explanation.

Points and authorities are needed: petitioner requests authority to release estate property to Mary Steinmetz without. Court records do not show that Steinmetz has been appointed personal representative of the estate of Nancy Bingham; however, court records also suggest she resided in Los Angeles County. Petitioner does not allege a legal or factual basis for surrender of property to Steinmetz. Public Administrator action may be required.

3. S-PR-0012678 In Re the Conservatorship of Thompson, Linda

Appearance is required for continued conservatorship status hearing.
