**PLACER COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT CONTINUES TO
SEEK VOLUNTEERS FOR GRAND JURY SERVICE**

The Superior Court of California, County of Placer continues to seek volunteers to serve on the 2026-2027 Placer County Grand Jury. The Court encourages applications from all citizens to enable the grand jury to represent a broad cross-section of the Placer County community. The one-year term for successful applicants begins on July 1, 2026 and ends on June 30, 2027.

The Placer County Grand Jury's primary function is to examine governments within Placer County, inclusive of the county government, city governments, and special districts to ensure that public agencies are conducting business in an appropriate and efficient manner.

To serve on the Placer County Grand Jury, you must be a Placer County resident over the age of 18. Service on the grand jury requires a substantial investment of time, usually 40-50 hours per month. Members of the grand jury receive a small stipend for their work.
