

# Joining a Zoom conference using your Browser

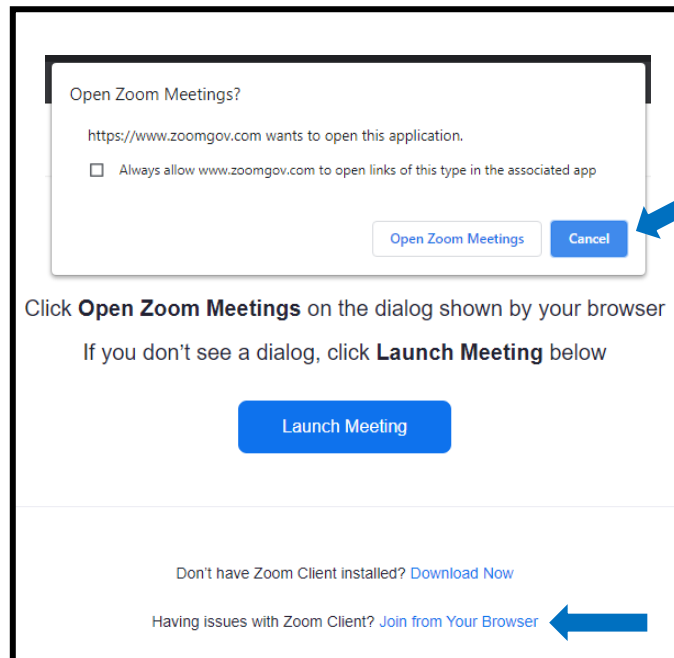
## Overview

Zoom supports the ability to join meetings directly from your Web Browser (Chrome, Firefox, Safari or Edge). Joining from the browser does **not** require the installation of a dedicated application and is great for first-time guests. For a better meeting experience, it is recommended that Hosts and frequent participants download and install the latest version of Zoom ([click here to download](#)).

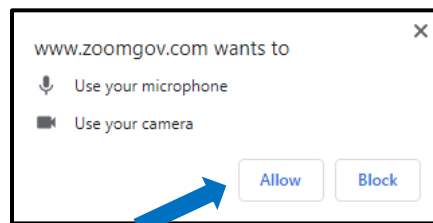
## How to Join from your Browser

Zoom supports the ability to join meetings directly from your Web Browser.

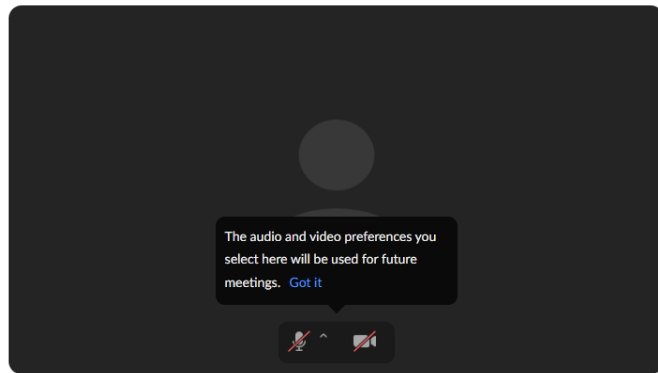
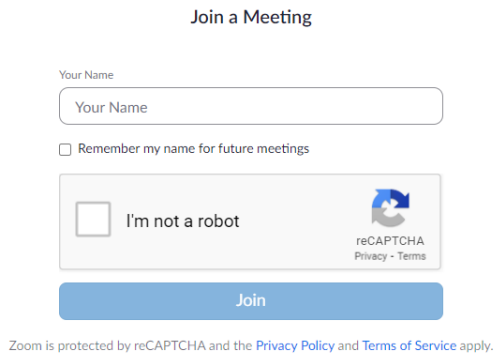
1. To start the join process, click the link provided to you by the Host.
2. On the Standby page, you'll be prompted to install the Zoom app on your first join attempt. **Instead**, click on **Cancel** and then the **Join from your Browser** button located at the bottom of the page.



3. Next, select **Allow** for your web browser to access/use your microphone and camera.



4. **Enter your name** and **complete the reCAPTCHA** service. You can select your audio and video preferences by using the **microphone/camera icons** to the right of the screen. These audio and video settings will be used for future meetings. Select **Join**.



5. If a meeting passcode is required to join this meeting, **enter the passcode** provided by the Host.
6. Once you have joined, you can join the audio by computer or dial in by telephone. If your device has a microphone, select **Join Audio by Computer**.
